

Early Stage Researcher Mobility Grant (ESRMG)

APPLICATIONS ARE INVITED for: Early-Stage Researchers in Metrology

ROLE OF THE ESRMG-RESEARCHER: The ESRMG-Researcher may propose any activities that add scientific value to an EMRP JRP. The proposed work must be additional to the Research contracted in the JRP. A full list of funded and selected JRPs can be found:

The ESRMG-Researcher will gain experience of an international collaborative project, and may have the opportunity to work with and/or produce joint papers with world-leading researchers

RESEARCHER REQUIREMENTS: The ESRMG-Researcher should have some experience in the technical area related to the JRP

PROJECT LOCATION(S): The research must be undertaken at a Guestworking Organisation located in a different country to the Researcher's employing organisation. A Guestworking organisation can be an NMI or DI in the JRP, or a REG Home Organisation.

DURATION: Between 3 and 12 months duration. The ESRMG must start after the JRP start date, and complete before the JRP end date

ALLOWANCES: The exact allowances for your situation can be found by using the "EMRP Researcher Grant Calculator" spreadsheet available at <http://www.emrponline.eu/downloads.html>

The EMRP Early-Stage Researcher Mobility Grant does not include a salary allowance. There is a fixed rate allowance of 1800 € /month living allowance (with an additional sum for those with a family who relocates with them), a further 500 € every 3 months as a travel allowance, and 200 € / month as a contribution to the Guestworking Organisation's overheads. In addition 1500 € may be claimed every 6 months for attendance at a specifically named conference or meeting. Note that some of these allowances are corrected for each country.

All applications must consist of a datasheet, Research Schedule (a description of the work to be undertaken), CV, and covering letter.

ESRMGs are open to researchers with fewer than 4 years experience, employed by an NMI or DI in an EU Member State or country associated to the Seventh Framework Programme.

The Guestworking Organisation must be a member of an EMRP JRP-Consortium (this includes funded or unfunded JRP-Partners) and must be located in a different country to the ESRMG-Researcher's current employing organisation
