The EMRP provides Early-Stage Researcher Excellence Grants (ESRMGs) to support early-stage researchers build experience of Metrology collaborations.

PROJECT: An ESRMG can be linked to any EMRP Joint Research Project (JRP) funded under A169. A full list JRPs funded in Call 2009-Energy can be found here:

WORK OF ESRMG BENEFICIARY: We welcome proposals that add scientific value to any aspect of the JRP, however the proposed work must be additional to the JRP objectives.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: Researchers should be able to demonstrate how the proposed work will build a better understanding of metrology collaboration, and develop their metrology skill.

PROJECT LOCATION(S): Applications are accepted for ESRMG Researchers to undertake guestworking at any member of the JRP-Consortium (funded or unfunded) but the Guestworking Organisation must be located transnationally to the Researcher's employing organisation.

DURATION: Between 3 and 12 months duration, though they will typically last for 6 months. Earliest start date is September 2010; with completion before the JRP end date.

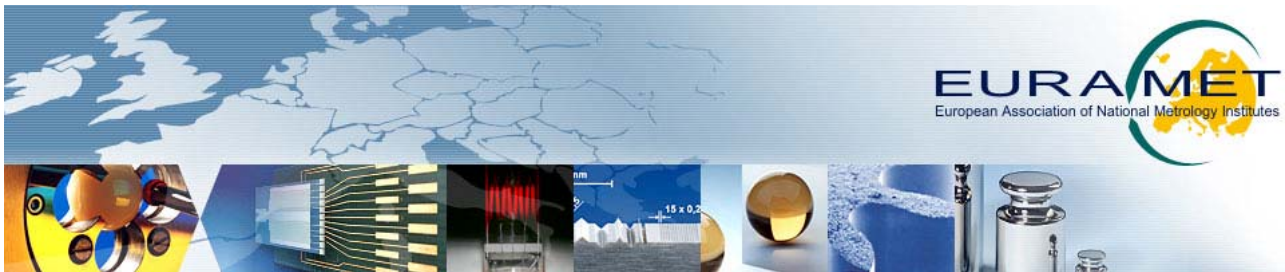
CLOSING DATE: This is an Open Call. The closing date for the first evaluations is **23:59 CET on Friday 7th May 2010**

ELIGIBILITY: ESRMGs are open to researchers with fewer than 4 years experience, from an NMI or DI in an EMRP participating states.

ALLOWANCES: The EMRP Early-Stage Researcher Mobility Grant does not include a salary allowance. There is a fixed rate allowance of 1800 €/month living allowance (with an additional sum for those with a family who relocates with them), a further 500 € every 3 months as a travel allowance, and 200 €/ month as a contribution to the guestworker organisation's overheads. In addition 1500 € may be claimed every 6 months for attendance at a specific named conference or meeting. Note that some of these allowances are corrected for each country.





HOW TO APPLY: Applications for ESRMG are made jointly by: the potential ESRMG recipient, their current employer, and the proposed Guestworking Organisation
